



Collection will be provided only on the days listed here. Residents who place garbage, recyclables or bulk at the curb on the wrong days may be fined a minimum of \$100 for each day the garbage is left out. Please cooperate and help prevent loose garbage and litter from blowing around Newark's streets.

Place garbage at the curb by 6:30 a.m. on your collection day. If you put your garbage and recyclables out the night before collection, please note the following:

From November 1st until April 30th, garbage and recyclables should be placed out for collection after 6 p.m. on the night before your scheduled collection. From May 1st until October 31st, garbage and recyclables should be placed out for collection after 8 p.m. on the night before your scheduled collection.

Garbage will **NOT BE COLLECTED** on **HOLIDAYS** that the City of Newark is **CLOSED**. Service will resume on your **NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED** collection day.

## TUESDAY AND FRIDAY (PURPLE PORTION)

### Tuesday Collection:

\*Garbage

\*Recyclable newspaper, magazines and cardboard.

\*These recyclable items should be tied and bundled with string or placed in brown paper bags. **DO NOT PLACE RECYCLABLE PAPER/CARDBOARD IN PLASTIC BAGS.**

### Friday Collection:

\*Garbage

\*Recyclable metal: soda cans, food cans, etc.

\*Recyclable glass: bottles and jars.

\*Recyclable plastic: milk jugs, soda/juice bottles.

Put recyclable bottles/cans in a sturdy, reusable container. **DO NOT PLACE RECYCLABLE BOTTLES/CANS IN PLASTIC BAGS.**

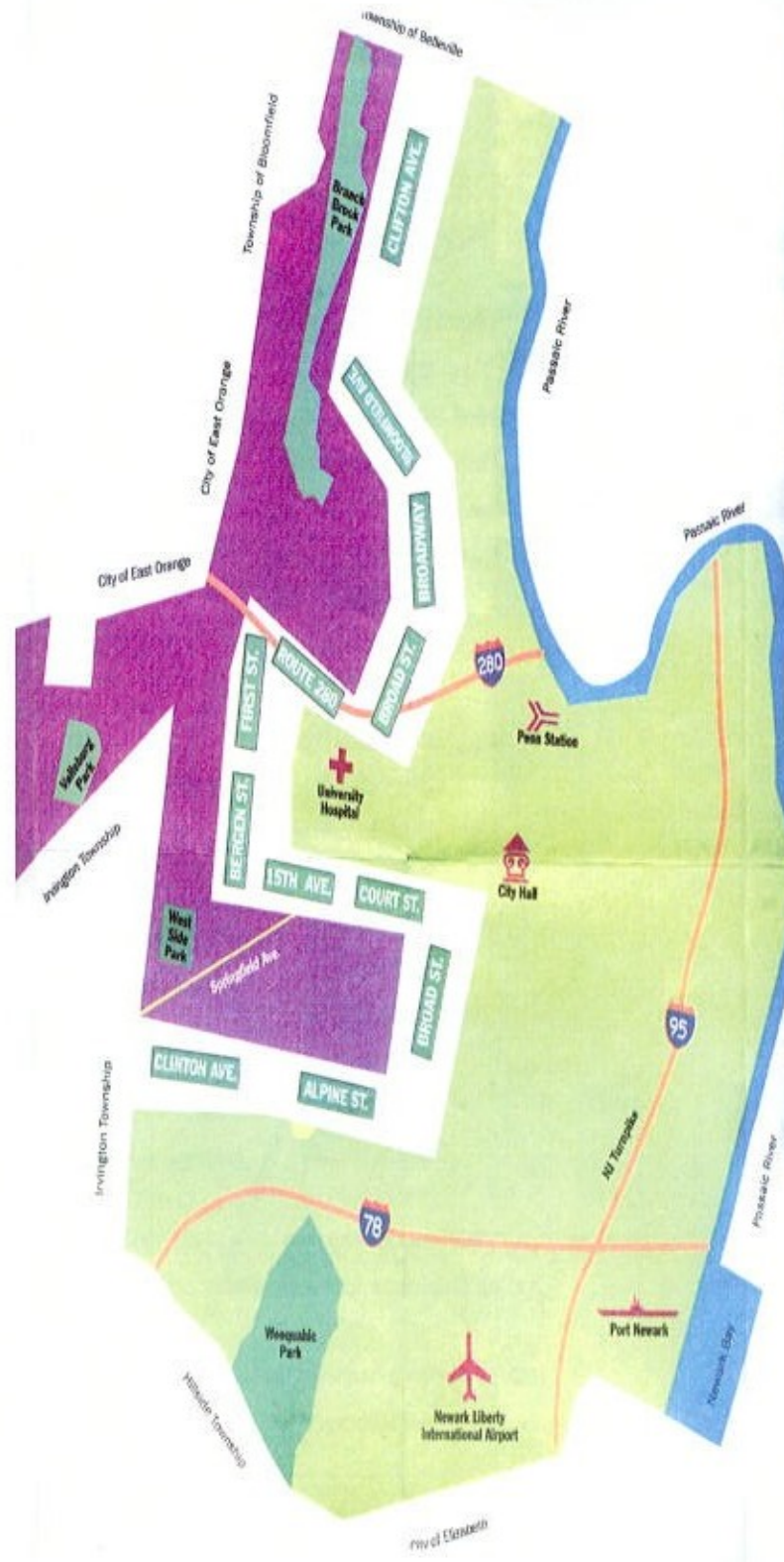

### Monday Collection:

\*Garbage

### Thursday Collection:

\*Garbage
